

2020-2021 Safety/ Health Guidelines for Re-opening of Crossroads Baptist Academy

1. Each morning parents will be asked to stay in their vehicle and pull up to the student drop off area located in the breezeway between the main auditorium and the school building.
2. Each staff member and student will have his/her temperature taken with a contactless thermometer before entering the buildings. Anyone with a temp of 100 degrees or above will not be permitted to stay.
3. We also ask that you not send your child if he/she has been sick during the night hours, even if they appear to feel better in the morning. Please be mindful of the Covid-19 signs (fever, cough, fatigue, difficulty breathing, headache, sore throat, congestion, nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea) and communicate with your child's teacher if a member of your household is diagnosed with Covid-19.
4. If at any time your child must be quarantined, our teachers will provide the necessary assignments to ensure that your child does not fall behind. If this happens, it will be the responsibility of the parent to see that these assignments are completed and turned in to the teacher.
5. No one class will have more than 12 students. This will allow us to put extra space between the desks.
6. Teachers will be required to have regular scheduled times for each student to sanitize their hands and desks. This will especially include the times entering or leaving the classroom.
7. Each student will have his/her own pencil and tools for learning.
8. Unless mandated by local authorities, facial masks will be permitted but not required. All face coverings must be solid colored. No patterns or writing will be permitted.
9. Lunch times and play times will be divided to keep areas open and allow us to put distance between our students.
10. Gloves will be worn by those heating and preparing food for all students.
11. Water fountains will not be used and we ask that you send a water bottle with your child each day to keep them hydrated.
12. Every class will be cleaned and sanitized at the end of each day.
13. Parent/Teacher Orientation will be held by appointments this year over a two day time period. Your child's teacher will be contacting you to find a time that is best for you.
14. All bathrooms and the lunch room areas will be cleaned and sanitized throughout the day.
15. There will be separate restrooms assigned for the lower elementary and upper grades. K-3 through 2nd grades will use the lunchroom restrooms, and the 3rd through 12th grades will use the restrooms next to the school office. Each classroom will have their own scheduled restroom times so that class groups are not overlapping in restrooms.
